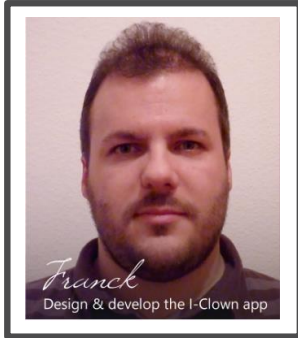


Who is behind the I-Clown project?
